

STUDY ABROAD OPTIONS AT SHSU

Exchange:



 Take courses at one of SHSU's partner universities outside of the country

Faculty-Led:



 Enroll in an SHSU course and travel with your SHSU professor and class for 1-4 weeks in the summer or winter

Affiliated/Non-Affiliated:



Study abroad through a third-party provider

National Student Exchange (NSE):

• Exchange with a student within U.S or Canada



APPLICATION DETAILS (EXCHANGE & AFFILIATED)

All students must complete two sets of applications:



1. Bearkat Abroad Portal

- Only one application is required apply to your #1 choice program
- Free to apply
- Access the portal here: Bearkat Abroad Portal
- Available programs: <u>Study Abroad Programs</u>

Non-affiliated programs (not listed) are also allowed but have additional conditions

APPLICATION DETAILS (EXCHANGE & AFFILIATED)



2. Apply to Your Program(s)

 You may apply to multiple programs while exploring your options. Once you've selected your #1 choice, notify the Study Abroad Office



Program Requirements Vary

• Some programs may have their own application fees





APPLICATION DETAILS (FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS)



All students must complete the application through the <u>Bearkat</u> <u>Abroad Portal</u>



Only one application is required - apply to your top-choice program



Free to apply



Consult with the program's faculty leader for specific program details



BEARKAT ABROAD PORTAL: WHAT TO EXPECT

Stage 1: Pre-Decision

- Before your application is approved, you'll need to:
 - Attend a Study Abroad Appointment (required for all programs except faculty-led)
 - **Attend a Student Money Management Appointment**
 - Verify faculty-led approval (for faculty-led programs) & confirm judicial standing
 - Submit your unofficial transcript
 - Sign financial responsibility agreements

Deadlines:



- Fall and Academic Year: March 15
- Spring and Summer: October 15

BEARKAT ABROAD PORTAL: WHAT TO EXPECT

Stage 2: Post-Decision

- After your application is approved, you'll need to:
 - Sign all required forms
- **Submit the Consortium Agreement Form**
- **Complete the Course Pre-Approval Form**
- Provide your contact and emergency contact information
- Submit your flight details
- Upload your passport and student visa
- Complete the Pre-Health Travel Survey

IMPORTANT NOTES



Required **forms and tasks may vary** depending on your program type Some tasks are **time-sensitive** and may affect:

- Financial aid
- Credit transfer
- Other key aspects of your study abroad experience




All tasks must be completed before departure



YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT

The following items will be charged to your SHSU account:

- Study Abroad Fee
- SHSU Travel Insurance Fee
- SHSU Tuition and Related Fees (applies only to Exchange and Faculty-Led programs)
- Program Fee (applies only to Faculty-Led programs)



ADDITIONAL FEES TO BE PAID DIRECTLY

- The following expenses will NOT be charged to your SHSU student account and must be paid directly to the program or independently
 - May include:
 - Application fees &/or deposits required by your program
 - Flights and transportation to and from your destination
 - Visa and passport costs (including renewals)
 - Insurance required by your program
 - Books and supplies
 - Personal expenses
 - Other fees itemized by your program


Important: If you receive an invoice from your program, payment must be made directly to the third-party provider





IMPORTANT PAYMENT INFORMATION


- Some programs require a **non-refundable deposit**, which you are responsible for paying:
- The SHSU Study Abroad fee is non-refundable
- If SHSU receives an invoice that includes your deposit, the amount will be credited toward your student account balance



HOW TO TRANSFER CREDITS: EXCHANGE & AFFILIATED/NON-AFFILIATED PROGRAMS

Course Pre-Approval Form

- Required for all students participating in study abroad
- Must include signatures from your academic advisor
- Available in your <u>Bearkat Abroad Portal</u> after your pre-approval
- Approved courses may count toward:
 - Major requirements
 - Minor requirements
 - Elective credit



HOW TO TRANSFER CREDITS: EXCHANGE & AFFILIATED/NON-AFFILIATED PROGRAMS

To have courses count toward your major or minor:

- Consult with your academic advisor
- Be aware: **Departments may limit** how many courses can transfer back
- Bring course syllabi and descriptions to your advising meeting to help with course evaluation



HOW TO TRANSFER CREDITS: EXCHANGE & AFFILIATED/NON-AFFILIATED PROGRAMS

To ensure your courses transfer successfully:



Have your program's official transcript sent to: Office of Study Abroad studyabroad@shsu.edu





- Your completed Course Pre-Approval Form
- The official transcript from your host institution
