Perceptions of Novice Elementary School Teachers on Their Preparedness for Teaching in Inclusive Classrooms

The purpose of this qualitative study was to analyze novice elementary educators' perceptions on their preparedness to teach inclusive classrooms. In this study, I found that novice teachers believed their educator preparation experience provided a basic understanding of special education concepts. However, the novice teachers' perceptions of their educator preparation program was that it did not provide adequate firsthand experiences to foster a greater sense of self-efficacy in their ability to teach in inclusive classrooms.
