Understanding Teacher Perceptions of Their Role in the Development of Student Academic Self-Efficacy

This study conducted interviews with faculty who teach developmental education courses at a community college in southeast Texas. The study examined teacher perceptions about student self-efficacy, what training and experience contributed to their current understanding, and what training they would like to receive. Emergent themes are reported based on the teachers' roles and the tools they utilize in the classroom. Implications for practice are discussed, and recommendations for future research are made according to the findings.
