Courses Offered - ECON 4360 & ECON 4085

These courses will cover: 1) the evolution and present of the business/economic system in China and 2) China's cultural and business practices. Please see the Department Chair of Economics and International Business for substituting these courses for other economics courses required by your degree plan.

Planned Trips Tiananmen Square, Forbidden City, Hyundai Factory Beijing, Yanjing Brewery, Great Wall of China, Terracotta Army Museum, 3-day trip to the city of Shanghai and another 3-day trip to the city of Xi'an.

Costs

1. Program fee is \$940 (includes all hotels, visa to China fee, all field trips and guided tours, bullet train transportation within China, subway card in Beijing and Shanghai, some meals, special activities, and guest lectures).
2. Airfare is approx. \$800 to \$900 for a Houston/Beijing round-trip flight.
3. Food and any other personal expenses. Recommended for three weeks: \$500 (recommended minimum \$400)
4. Tuition for 6 hours ~ \$2,500

Scholarships - There are two scholarships available:

1. The College of Business Administration (COBA) offers a scholarship of \$940 for the first ten students admitted to the program and \$600 for the eleventh student. To qualify, you only need to be a business major with a SHSU GPA of at least 3.0. Application sheet is available from Dr. Gonzalez.
2. The Office of International Programs (OIP) offers scholarships to students with a GPA of at least 3.0. Last year the OIP scholarship was \$800. Deadline to apply is February 1st. See: http://www.shsu.edu/~int_www/abroad/scholarships.html

Accommodation: all accommodations are included in the program fee. The accommodation in Beijing is conveniently located on the CUMTB campus in the middle of the college life of Beijing.

Important Dates and How to Apply

2. \$300 deposit paid within one week of being accepted into program.
3. March 10th - \$250 of program fee due; April 10th - \$250 of program fee due.
4. May 10th - the remaining \$140 of program fee due.
