

STUDENT ORGANIZATION BENEFITS

As a recognized student organization at SHSU, you receive the following benefits:

Host Events on Campus

Ability to reserve rooms and outdoor space in and around the Lowman Student Center.

Event Access and Leadership Development

SHSU hosts several events accessible only to recognized organizations such as Passport to SAM, Saturday @ SAM, President and Vice President Roundtables, SOLR – Student Organization Leadership Retreat, Treasurer Training and Officer Transition Training.

Institutional Media

Only recognized student organizations can be promoted on campus, in departmental media, and in newsletters.

Collaborations

Only recognized student organizations can collaborate with an on campus entity. Non-recognized organizations must receive approval from the Office of the President in order to collaborate.

Awards

Several SHSU awards, such as The Sammys, require that organizations be recognized in order to be eligible for an award.

Special Funding Opportunities

The Campus Life Development Fund and Student Organization Travel Fund are only available to recognized student organizations.

Organization Contests

Opportunity to participate in Financial Literacy Week, Homecoming Spirit Competition, and more.

Resources and Services

The Department of Leadership Initiatives grants access to butcher paper, a die cutter, a computer work station, approves flyers, and provides up to 50 free copies per week. Grants access to a free Graphic Artist, and approves raffle requests.

OrgLINK

Recognized student organizations are given a website in OrgLINK where they can communicate with members, advertise events, and store documents, manage membership rosters, connect with potential members and more.

Incentive Programs

The Department of Leadership Initiatives provides a number of incentive programs that allow recognized student organizations to receive money or recognition for their work.

Organization Consultations

Organizations are provided with an opportunity to receive consultations for handling conflict, risk management, waivers, and more.
