Algebraic Majors – Math Developmental Course Tracks


- Placement is primarily determined by a student's TSI Math Diagnostic Score.
 - If a student has a diagnostic score of 0-3, they will take a minimum of two semesters of developmental course work before becoming college ready.
 - If a student has a diagnostic score of 4-5, they will take a minimum of one semester of developmental course work before becoming college ready.

Diagnostic Score of 0 – 3:

- Students take MATH 0331 as a stand-alone developmental course their first semester.
 - If a student makes an A or B in MATH 0331, they take limited support corequisite math (sections 60 79) their second semester.
 - If a student makes a C in MATH 0331, they take full support corequisite math (sections 80+) their second semester.
 - o If a student makes a D or F in MATH 0331, they will repeat MATH 0331 for a C or better their second semester.

Diagnostic Score of 4 – 5:

- Student's placement depends on if they are a first-time freshman or a continuing or transfer student.
 - If a student is a first-time freshman and has a GPA of 3.6 or higher, they will take limited support corequisite math (sections 60 – 79).
 - If a student is a first-time freshman and has a GPA of 3.59 or less, they will take full support corequisite math (sections 80+).
 - o If a student is a continuing or transfer student, they will take full support corequisite math (sections 80+).

• Placement is determined solely by student type and GPA, and students take a minimum of one semester of developmental coursework.


First-Time Freshmen:

- First-time freshmen with a GPA of 3.4 or above will take limited support corequisite math (sections 60 79).
- First-time freshmen with a GPA of 3.39 or below will take full support corequisite math (sections 80+).

Transfer and Continuing Students:

• All transfer and continuing students will take full support corequisite math (sections 80+).

• Placement is determined solely by students' TSI ELAR diagnostic scores, and students take a minimum of one semester of developmental coursework.

Diagnostic Score of 0 – 3:

• Students take ENGL 1301 and full support INRW 0014.

Diagnostic Score of 4 – 5 or TSI ELAR score of 945+ and TSI Essay score of 4 or less:

• Students take ENGL 1301 and limited support INRW 0011.
