Sam Houston State University awards undergraduate credit for physical education core curriculum courses KINE 2115 and up to 12 credit hours for general electives to military veterans who meet certain requirements.

House Bill 269 makes military veterans who enroll in Texas universities and who meet certain requirements eligible to receive undergraduate college credit for the time they spent in the service. Eligible veterans receive college credit for all the required physical education courses needed for their degree and up to additional 12 semester hours of elective coursework.
