- The purpose of your paper/creative project
- Outline of the questions to be addressed or the creative project to be undertaken
- Methodology/Creative Process
- Thesis of the paper/Creative Reflection answers
- Implications
- A 75-word abstract for the Graduate Research Exchange program.
