Educational & Experience Requirement: Doctoral degree in clinical or counseling psychology and licensure as a Psychologist are required. Three years of experience in psychotherapy, crisis intervention, psychological services, and/or psychological assessment. Will consider practicum, internship, and post-doctoral internship as eligible experience. A combination of education, experience, and training that would produce the required knowledge and abilities could be considered.

Nature & Purpose of Position: Provides supervision of doctoral students and psychological services to the community.

Supervision Given & Received: Works under general direction and supervises doctoral students.

Primary Responsibilities: Typical areas of responsibility include supervision of assessment with both children and adults. Assessments most commonly include personality, psychodiagnostics, intelligence, and achievement. The individual would supervise psychotherapy with children, adults, couples, and families. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Other Specifications: Possess strong skills in the areas of psychotherapy, crisis intervention, and supervision. Demonstrate strong problem-solving skills and the ability to develop, implement, and evaluate effective treatment plans. Have an ability to work with a diverse population. Availability for some evening hours is desirable.
