

Study of Internet vs. Face to Face Drop Rate & Other Outcomes S08 through F10

Summary

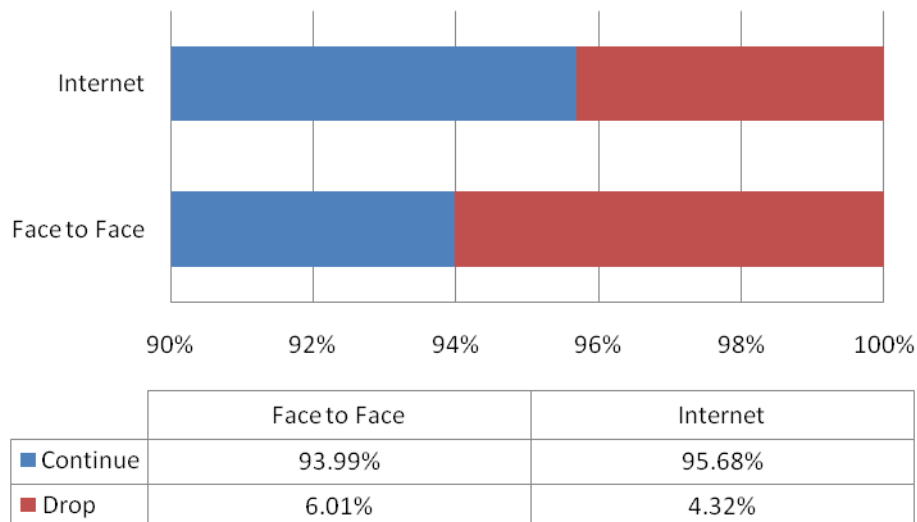
All reported outcomes are based upon “course tickets” (duplicated headcounts)

- When class levels are disaggregated Internet classes have higher drop rates than F2F, EXCEPT at the doctoral level
- Drop rates in Lower and Advanced level Undergraduates classes are markedly higher than in F2F classes.
- When all levels, terms and years are considered together, Internet classes overall are shown to have a lower drop rate than Face to Face (F2F) classes.
- In general, masters level classes have lower drop rates than undergraduate classes of either mode and this level makes up 66% of all internet class tickets, but only 5% of F2F class tickets

Drop Rates, Internet vs. Face to Face, Across All Levels and Terms

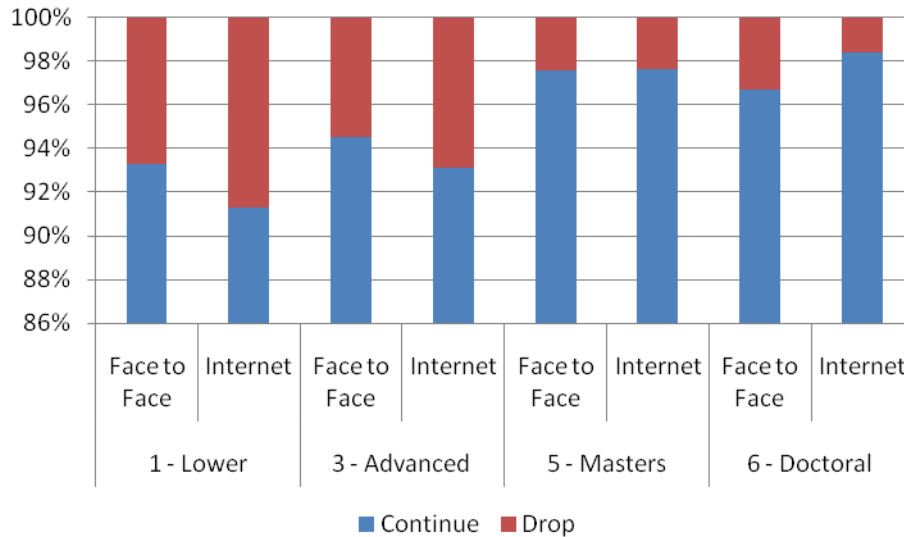

Percentages of Dropped Classes by Level, Mode, Across All Terms



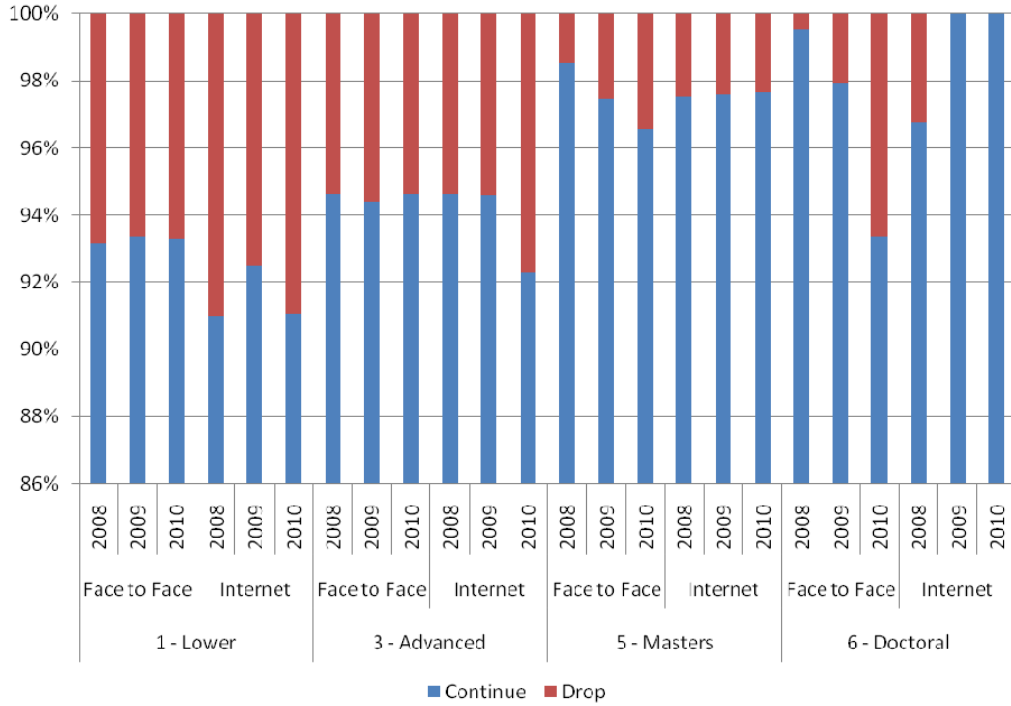

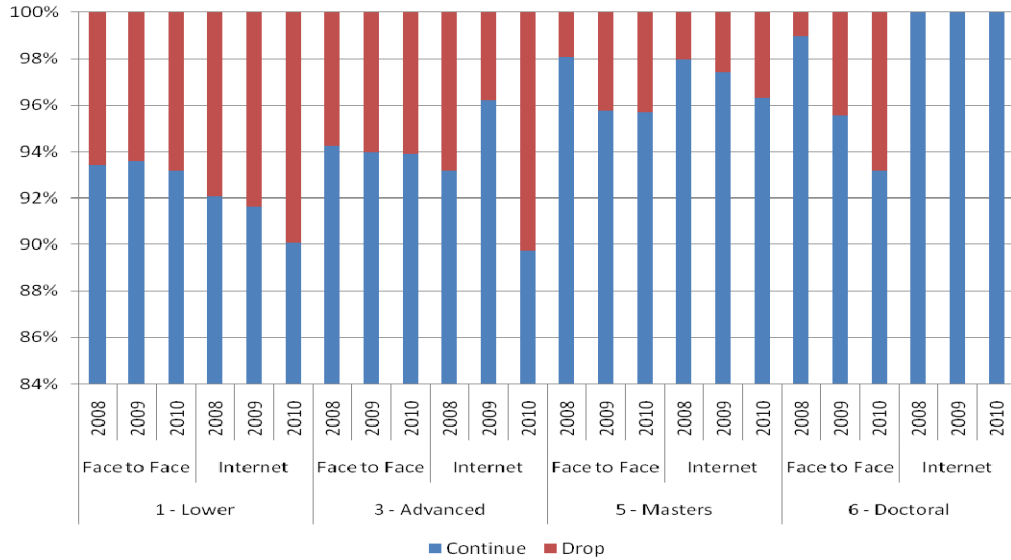

Drop Rates, Fall Semesters by Level, Mode, Year

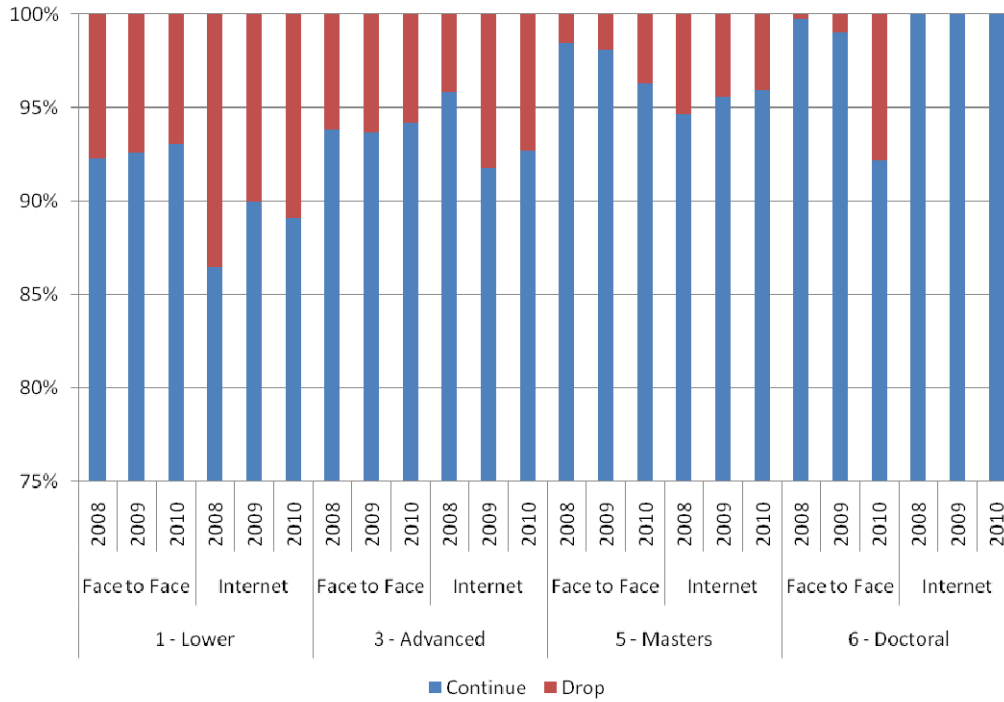

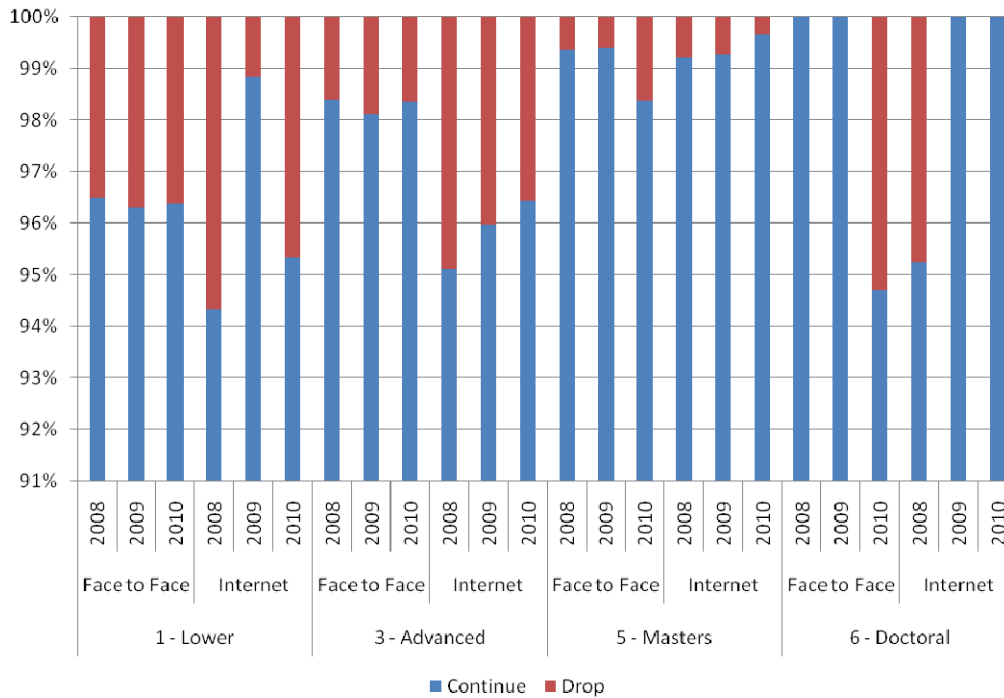

Drop Rates, Summer Semesters by Level, Mode, Year



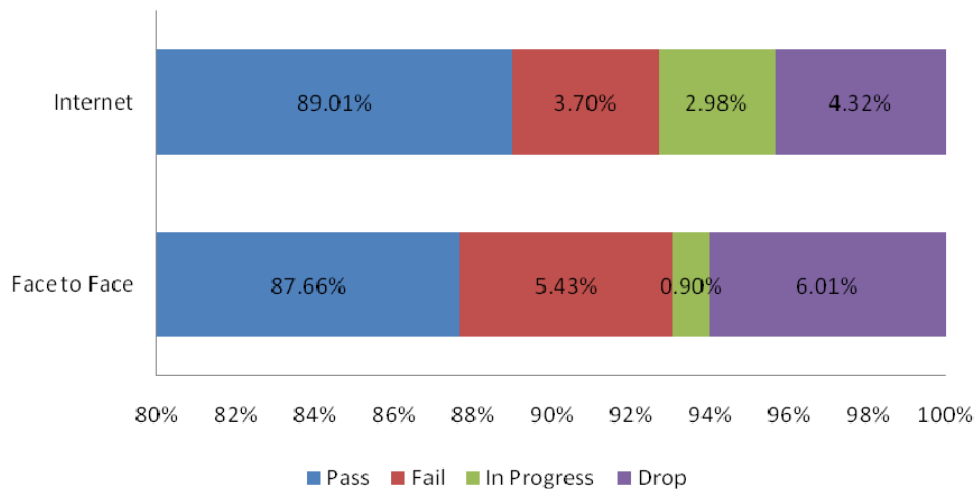
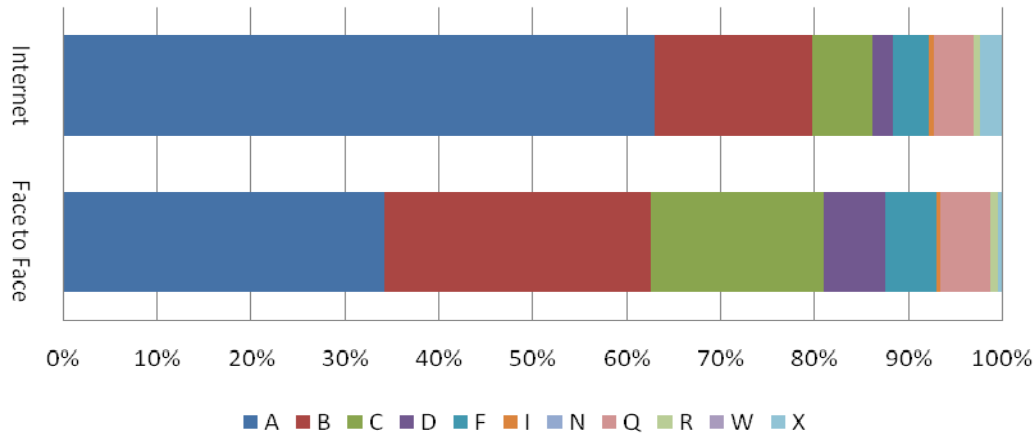

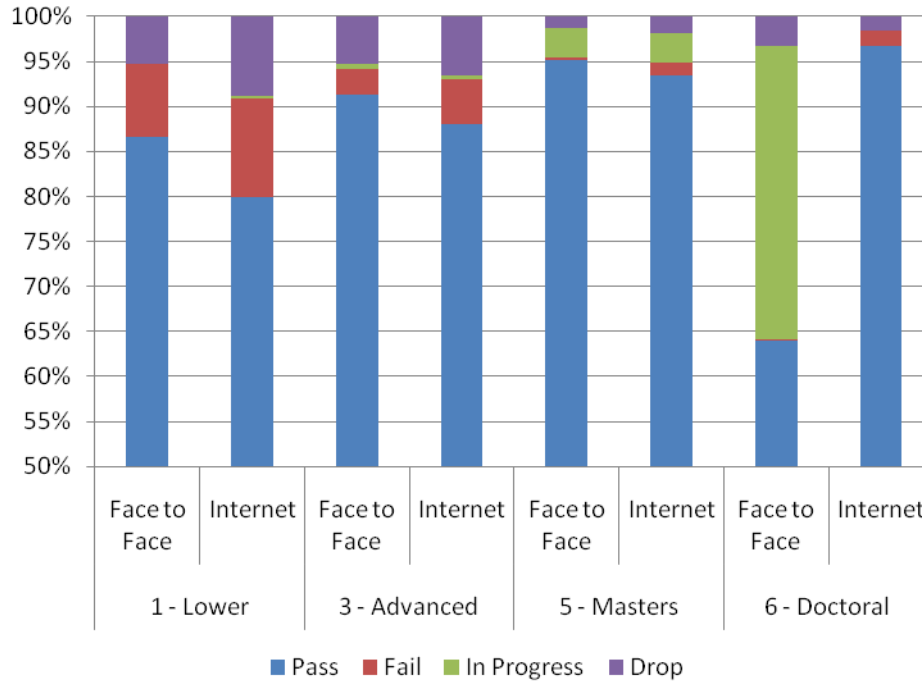

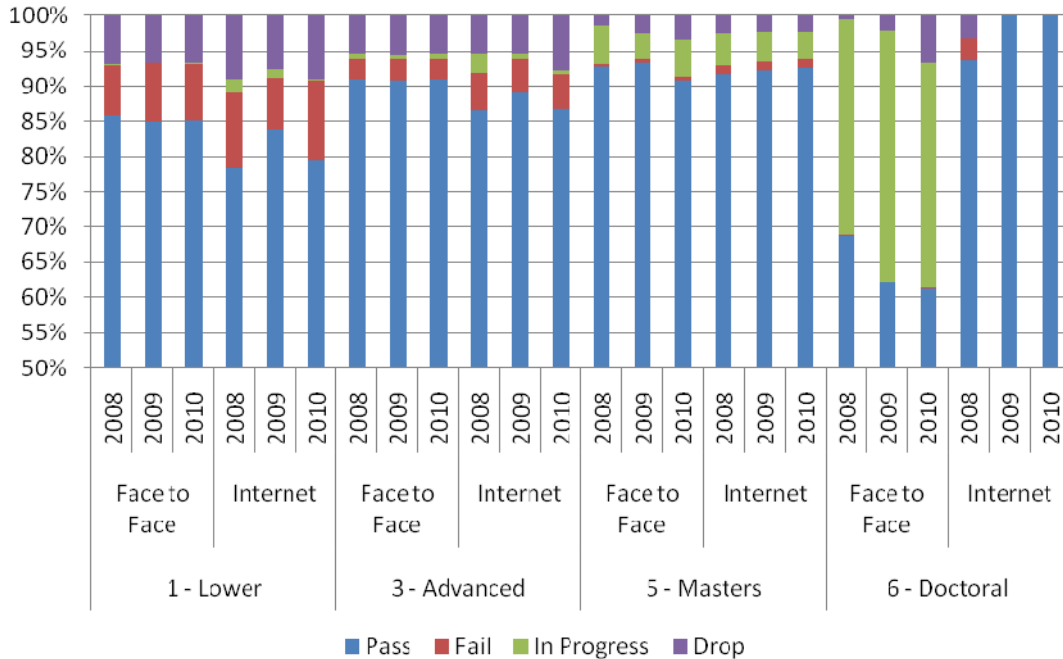

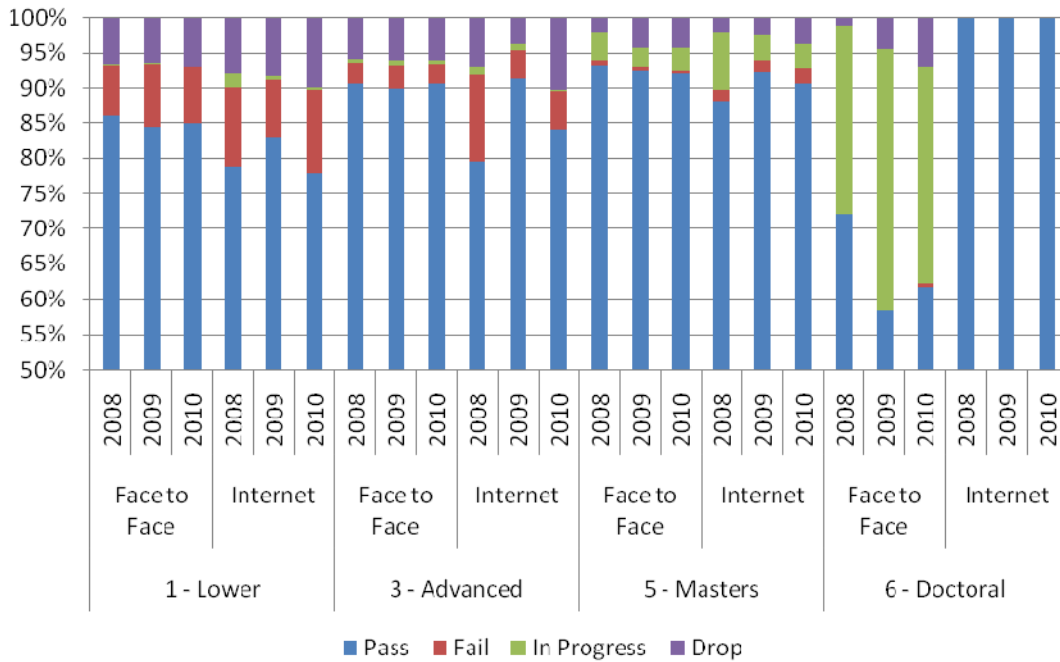

Summarized Outcomes, Fall Semesters by Level, Mode, Year

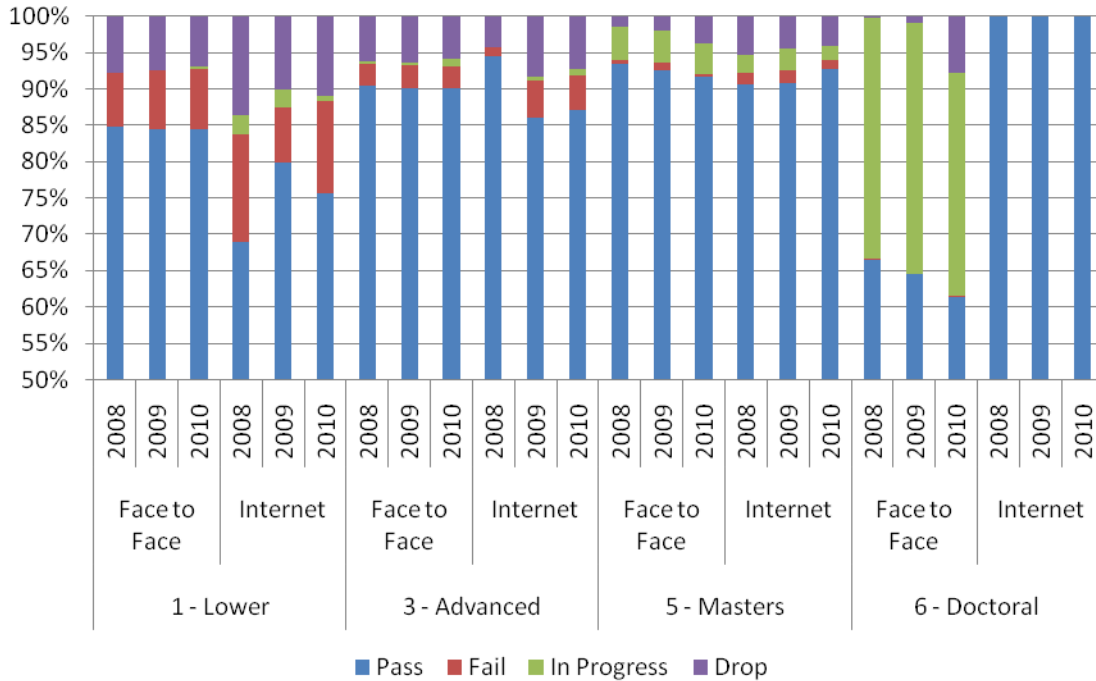

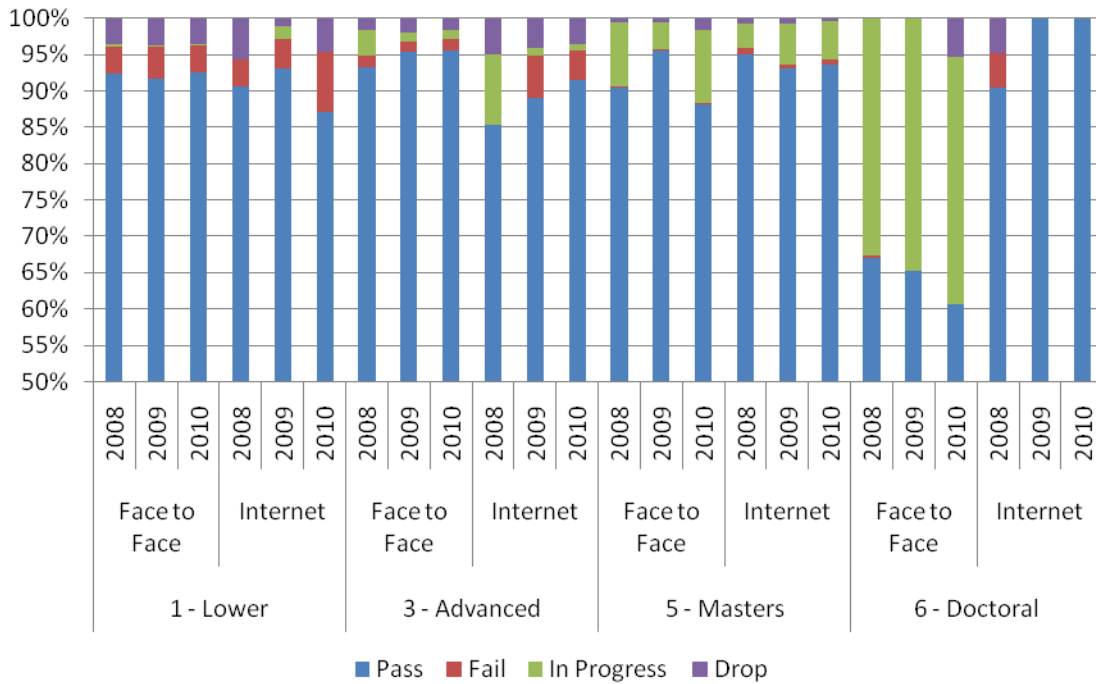

Summarized Outcomes, Summer Semesters by Level, Mode, Year



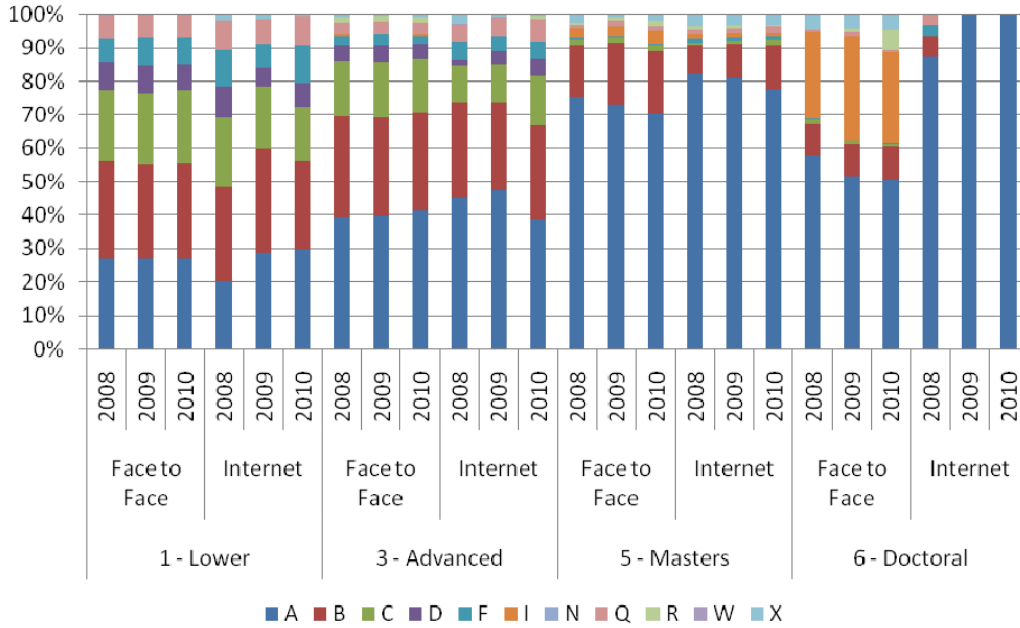

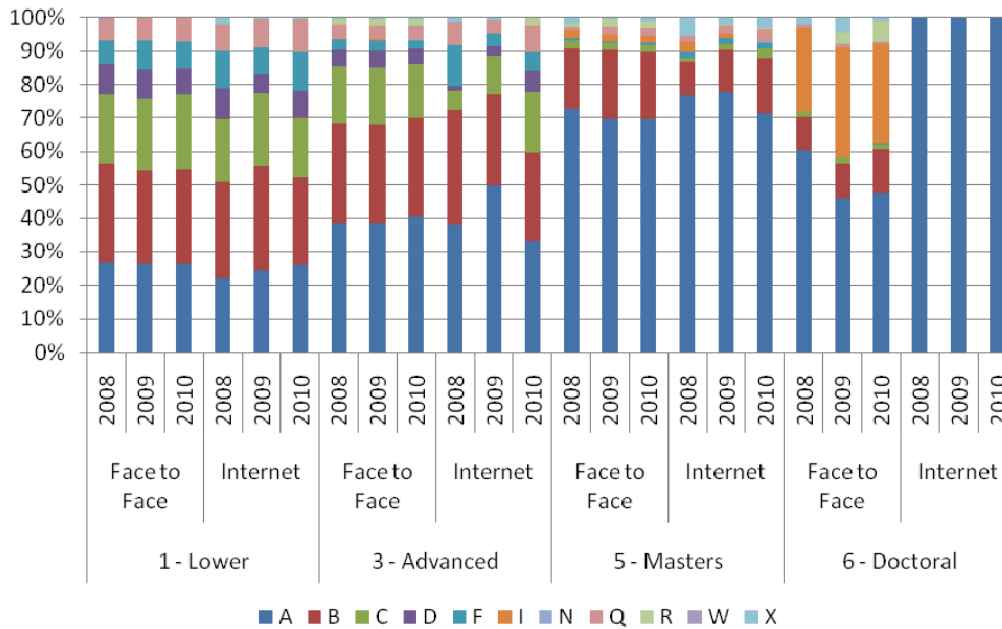

Detailed Outcomes, Fall Semesters by Level, Mode, Year

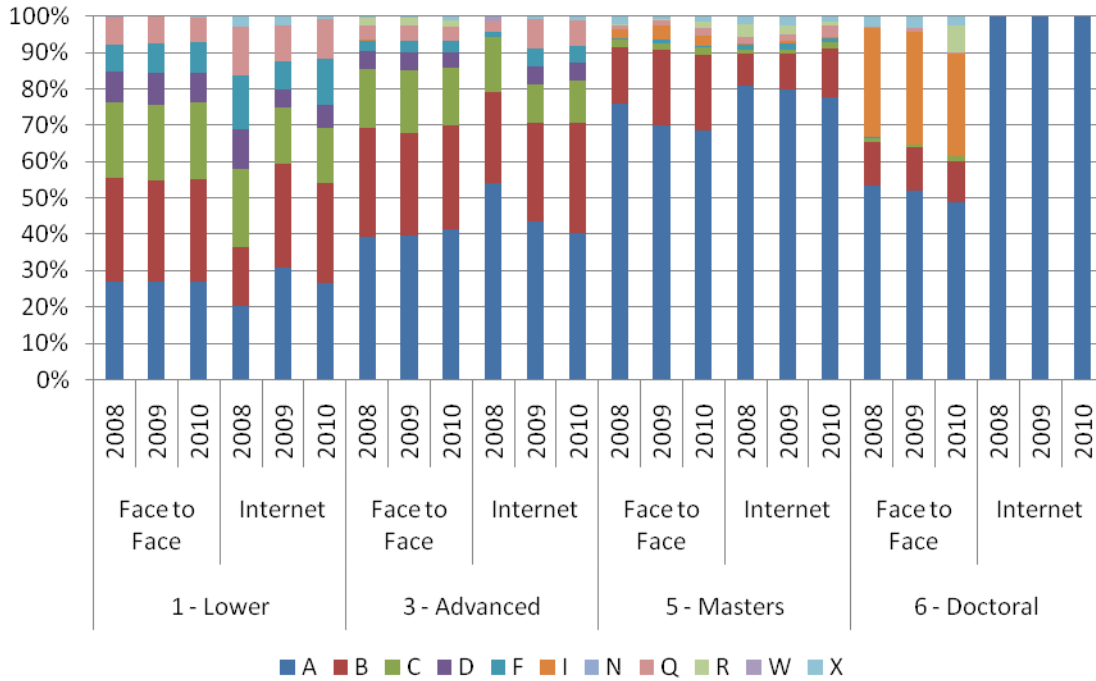

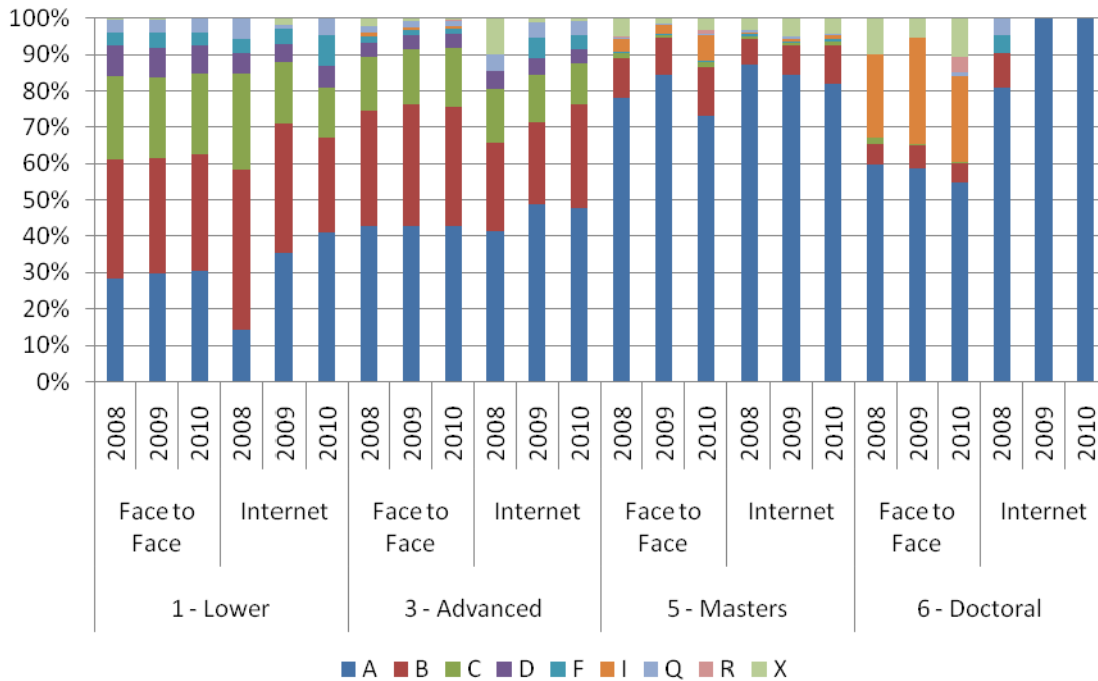

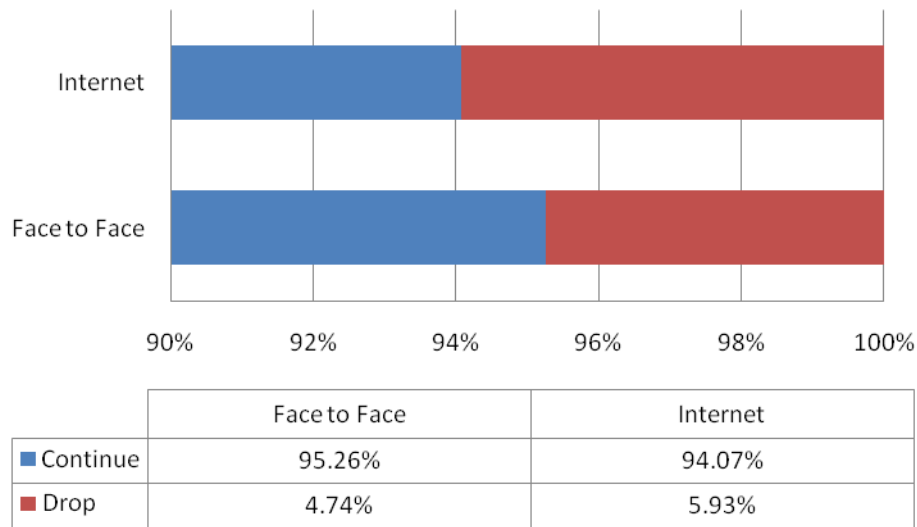
Dual Mode Class Outcomes

These graphs represent only classes that are taught with both modes in the same semester, Face to Face and Internet.

Outcomes reported below apply only to courses that were offered in both internet and F2F modes:

- In courses that have been delivered in both internet and F2F modes, those delivered via internet tended to have higher drops
- When examined by College, across levels, drop rates in COE classes delivered via internet were lower than the same courses delivered F2F
- When examined by College, across levels, drop rates in COAS, COBA and CHSS classes delivered F2F were markedly lower than the same courses delivered via internet.
- The difference in drop rates between F2F and Internet mode deliveries of the same courses were most dramatic in CHSS and COAS
- The difference in the proportion of passing grades earned in F2F and Internet mode deliveries of the same courses was quite marked in COAS and CHSS
- In COE courses delivered in both modes, the pass rate was slightly higher in courses delivered via internet

Dual Mode Course Drop Rates, Internet vs. Face to Face, Across All Levels and Terms

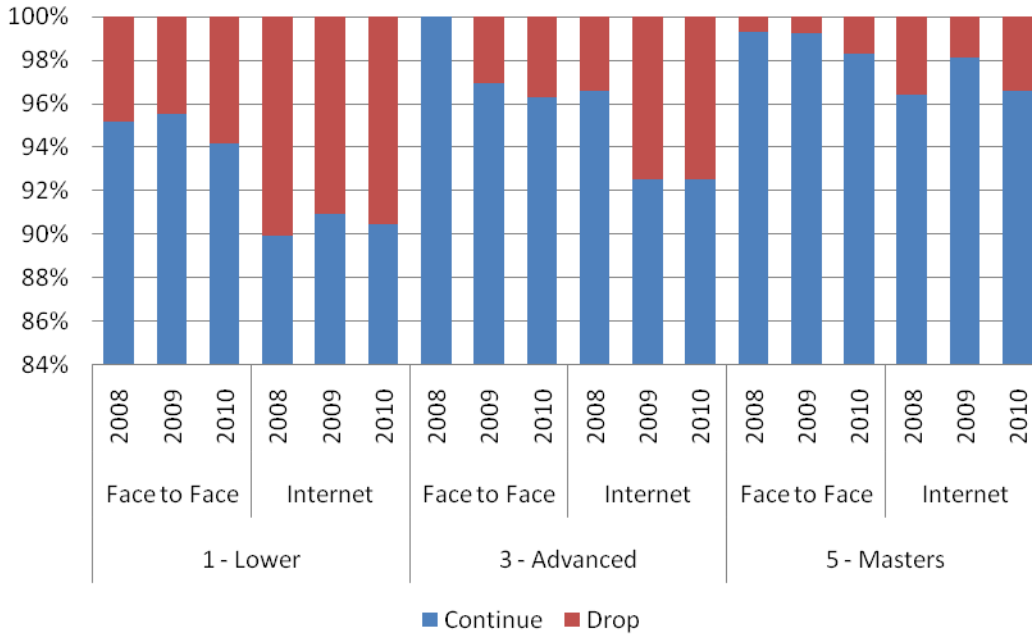

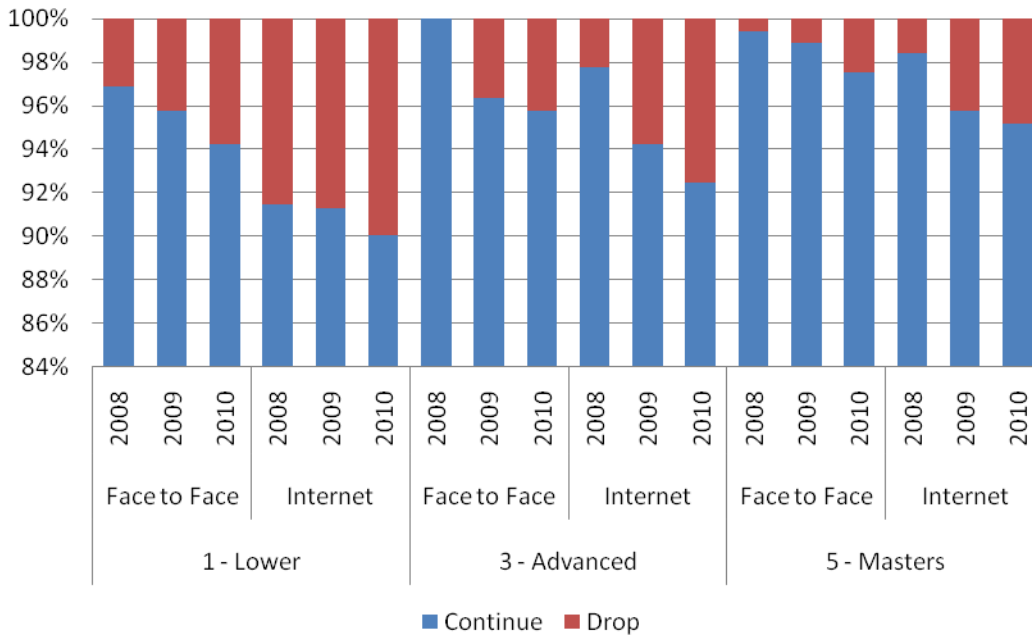

Dual Mode Drop Rates, Fall Semesters by Level, Mode, Year



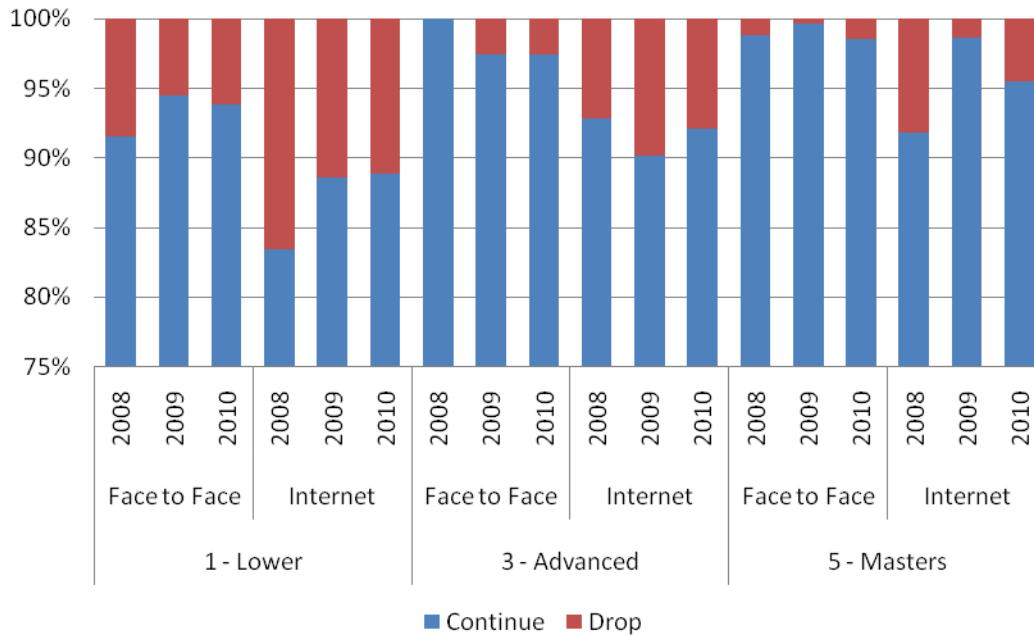

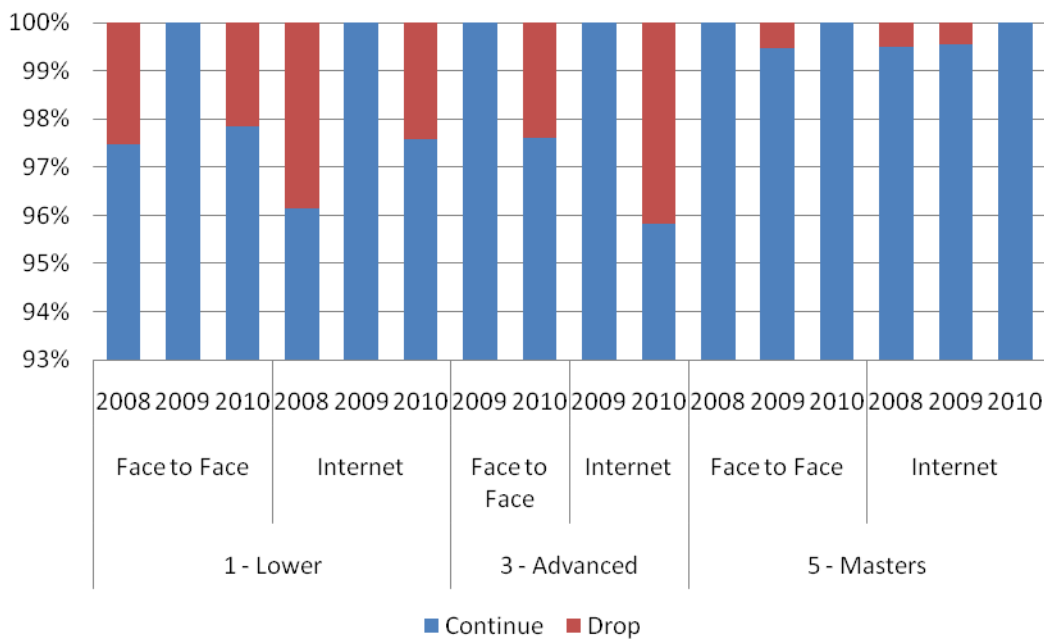

Dual Mode Drop Rates, Summer Semesters by Level, Mode, Year



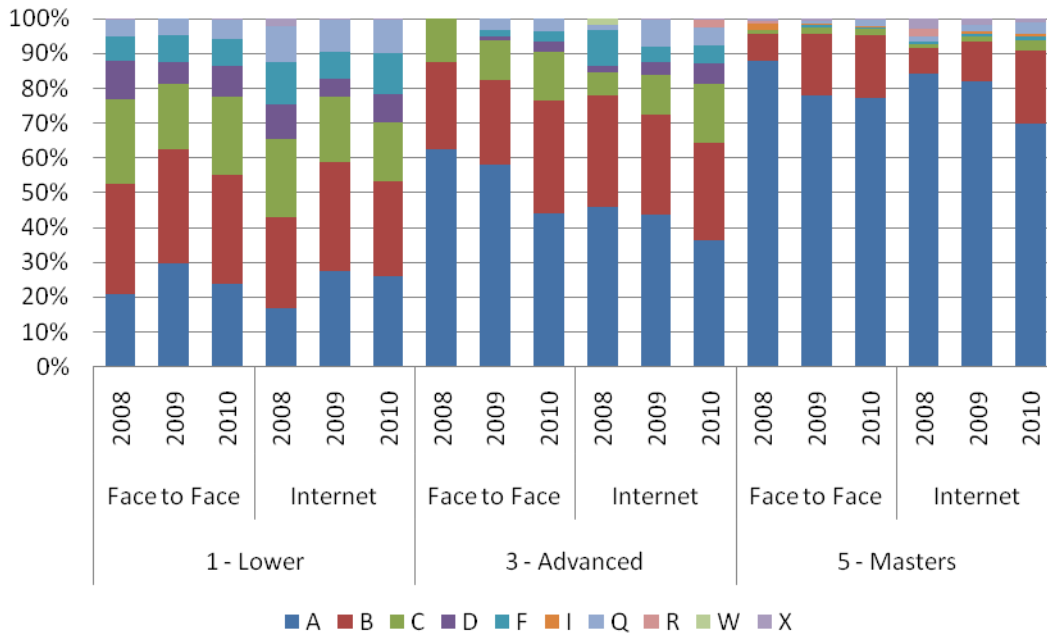

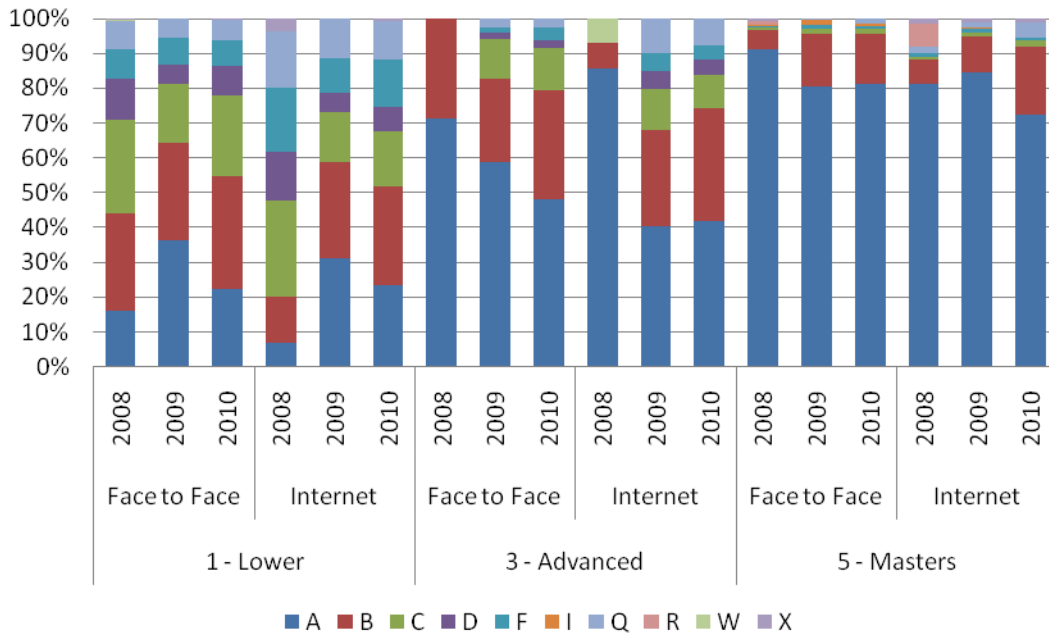

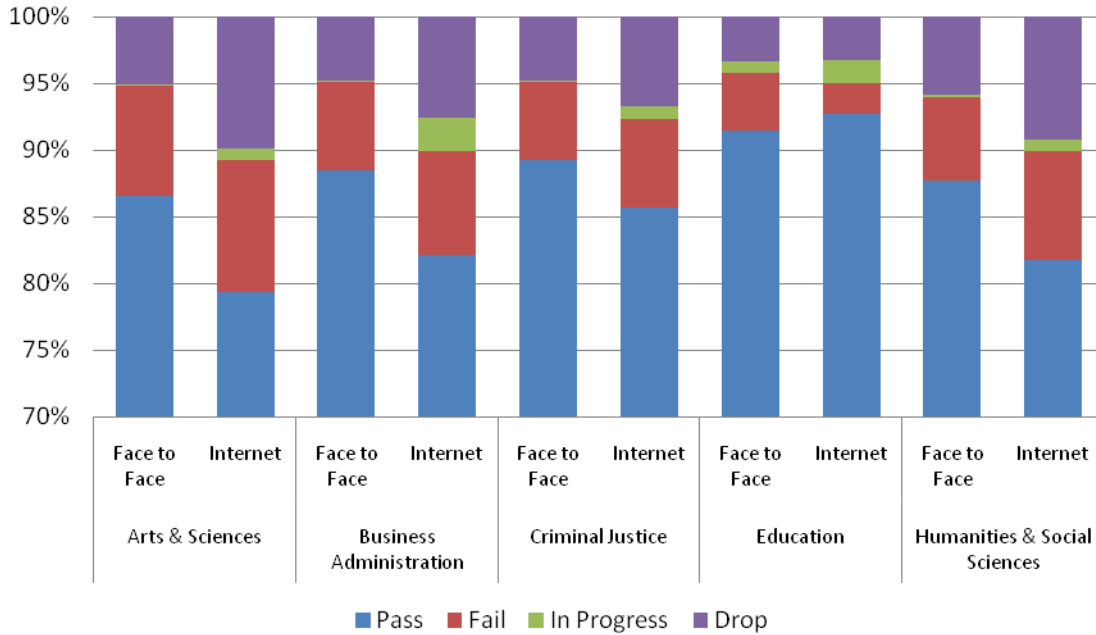

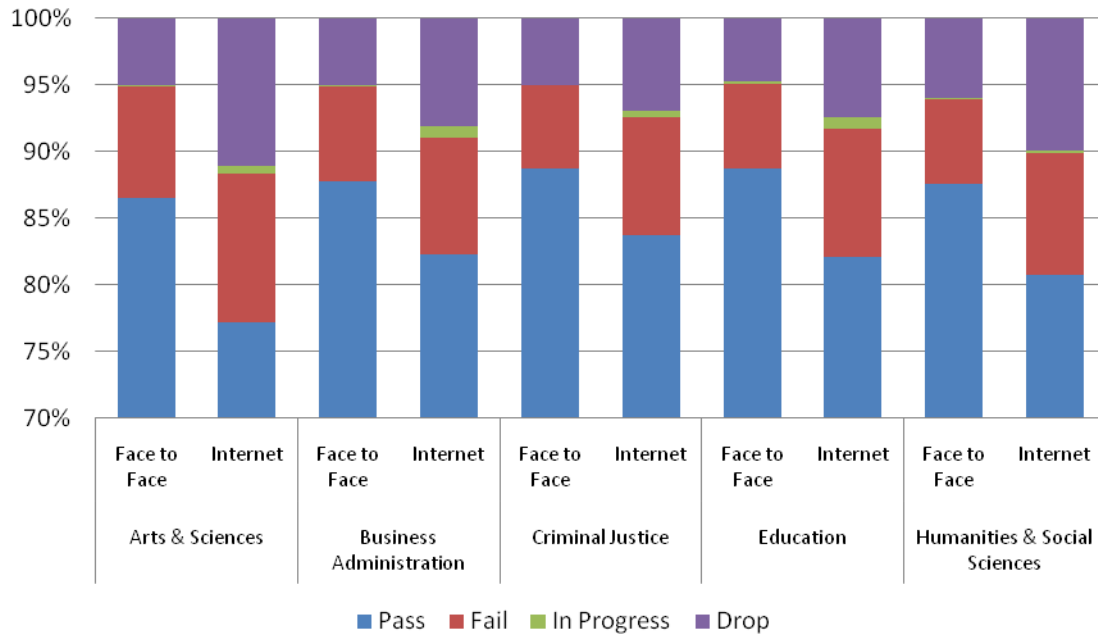

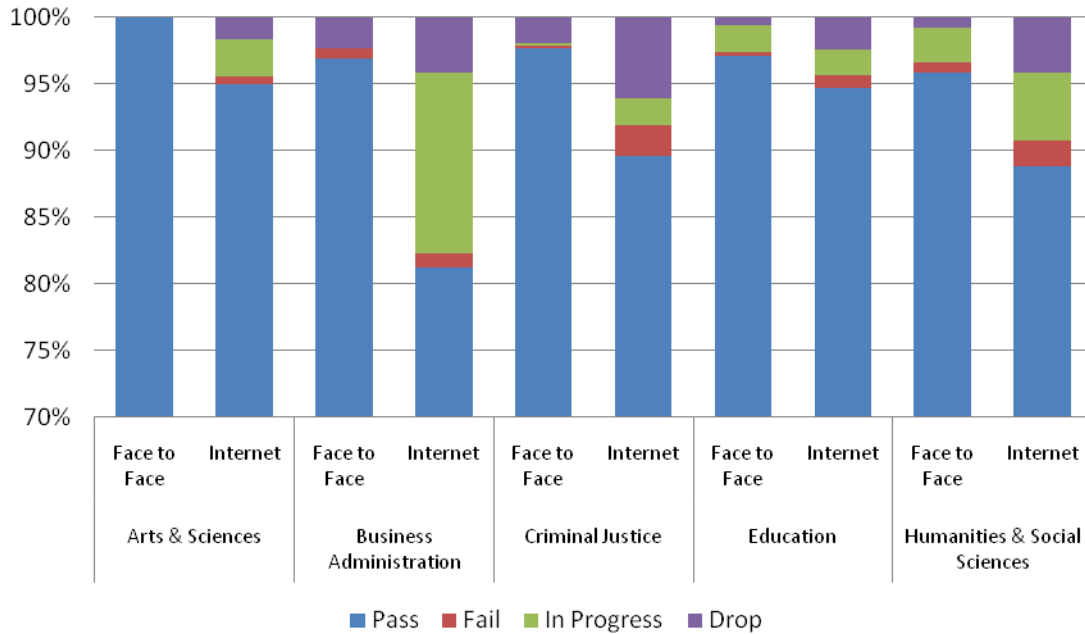
