Nature & Purpose of Position: Plans, organizes, and directs the day-to-day operations of a department with the oversight of the Director. Performs highly complex managerial work providing direction and guidance in strategic operations and planning in the department, college, or division.

Supervision Given & Received: Works under minimum direction and supervises employees.

Primary Responsibilities: Directs program activities of staff in a business function, division or department. Develops and implements techniques for evaluating program activities. Develops goals and objectives. Oversees and approves schedules, priorities, and standards for achieving goals. Develops, implements, and evaluates policies and procedures and oversees compliance with policies and procedures. Oversees schedules, priorities and standards for achieving goals. Identifies areas of needed change and makes recommendations to improve operations. Directs and evaluates business function, division, or department activities. Develops and reviews budget expenditures. Oversees the work of others. Oversees the preparation of management and productivity reports and studies. Manages programs focusing on continuous process improvement. Develops and implements techniques for evaluating program activities. Makes decisions independently under the authority of the director when the director is absent. Enforces department policies and procedures. Performs other duties as assigned.

Other Specifications: Knowledge of local, state, and federal laws. Ability to manage business functions. This position may be designated as a Campus Security Authority (CSA).
