## ADJUNCT FACULTY EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARD

## DESCRIPTION

This award is to recognize outstanding teaching by the instructors, clinical faculty, and adjunct faculty of the College of Sciences. The Awards & Recognition Committee will select the instructor, clinical faculty member, or adjunct faculty member who best demonstrates exemplary teaching in our college.

## **G**UIDELINES

- 1. Nominees must be instructors, clinical faculty members, or adjunct faculty members with an appointment in the College of Sciences at Sam Houston State University.
- 2. Letters of nomination will be accepted from a department chair or faculty member in the College of Sciences. Student nominations and self-nominations are not accepted.
- 3. Nominees must have demonstrated a pattern of excellence in teaching and learning activities during classes taught at Sam Houston State University, its satellite campuses, or in on-line classes. Examples include but are not limited to publishing in educational journals, conducting educational workshops, and redesigning curriculum.
- 4. Observation of a candidate's teaching will not be a part of the selection process.
- 5. Nominees must submit the following materials:
  - a. a resume or vitae (no page limit),
  - b. a brief narrative describing teaching philosophy (one-page limit),
  - c. a brief narrative accepting the nomination and describing activities, innovations, results, professional development to improve teaching, etc., that supports the nominee's outstanding teaching (two-page limit),
  - d. IDEA student evaluations from the previous five semesters (if applicable), and
  - e. letters of support from colleagues or students or alumni (limit two).
- 6. Prior award winners may not be nominated for the award for a period of five (5) years after receiving the award.
