# WHAT IS TITLE IX?

Title IX states: No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

## KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

### EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Title IX prohibits a school from excluding a pregnant student from any part of its educational programs, including all extracurricular activities, such as school organizations, academic societies, honors programs, internships, or sports. Pregnant athletes (and those with related conditions) must be treated like any other athlete with a temporary disability.

### PRIORITY REGISTRATION FOR PARENTING STUDENTS

The University provides certain early registration options for parenting students. Students must self-certify each semester to receive priority registration through the Registrar's Office.

## EXPECTANT PARENT FAQ

**Q. What if I need to miss class or cannot meet assignment deadlines due to pregnancy?**

**A.** If an absence memo is needed, Title IX & Student Discrimination Resolution may grant this accommodation request if the absence is related to the student's pregnancy, childbirth or any resulting medical status or condition. Professors may require the student to complete missed assignments or other missed work to make up for missed participation.

**Q. What happens to my full-time student status if I cannot attend class regularly during a semester?**

**A.** Title IX gives the student the opportunity to take a leave of absence if they are in good academic standing at the time of the requested leave.

**Q. What happens to my on campus housing once I deliver my child?**

**A.** Since students are not allowed to live on campus with children, a request to terminate the contract agreement can be submitted through the Residence Life housing portal.

**Q. What happens when I'm pregnant and still need to attend classes?**

**A.** Title IX allows students to make reasonable adjustments, such as a larger desk, temporary parking accommodations or the ability to make frequent trips to the restroom due to pregnancy.
