PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Professionals in health care quality and safety manage the strategic and operational aspects of quality operations; establish goals and standards; create the quality improvement tools and techniques; develop, implement and monitor measures to assess quality performance; direct organization-wide quality initiatives including the National Patient Safety Initiatives; and direct ongoing monitoring of accreditation survey readiness activities.
